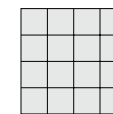

Imported from Spain, BATON comes in a range of sleek, monochrome colours. The unique format of 50x400mm makes this a great alternative to the standard subway, brick tile.

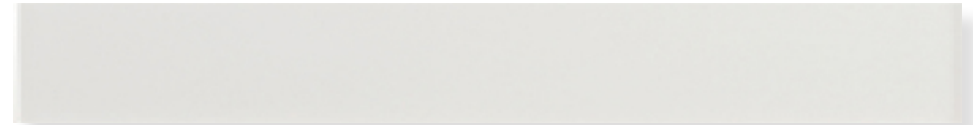

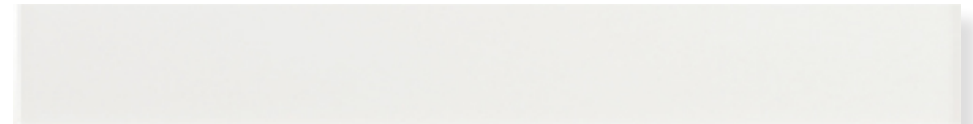

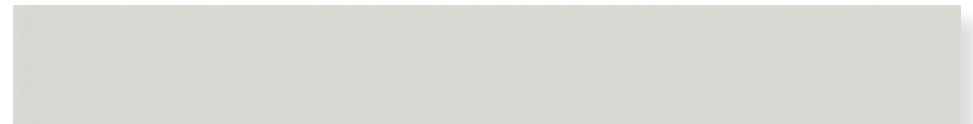
